#### A Song of Praise to God Coming in Judgment

**96** Oh, sing to the LORD a new song! Sing to the LORD, all the earth.  
<sup>2</sup> Sing to the LORD, bless His name;  
Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.  
<sup>3</sup> Declare His glory among the nations,  
His wonders among all peoples.  
<sup>4</sup> For the LORD *is* great and greatly to be praised;  
He *is* to be feared above all gods.  
<sup>5</sup> For all the gods of the peoples *are* idols, But the LORD made the heavens.  
<sup>6</sup> Honor and majesty *are* before Him;  
Strength and beauty *are* in His sanctuary.  
<sup>7</sup> Give to the LORD, O families of the peoples,  
Give to the LORD glory and strength.  
<sup>8</sup> Give to the LORD the glory *due* His name;  
Bring an offering, and come into His courts.  
<sup>9</sup> Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness!  
Tremble before Him, all the earth.  
<sup>10</sup> Say among the nations, "The LORD reigns;  
The world also is firmly established, It shall not be moved;  
He shall judge the peoples righteously."  
<sup>11</sup> Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad;  
Let the sea roar, and all its fullness;  
<sup>12</sup> Let the field be joyful, and all that *is* in it.  
Then all the trees of the woods will rejoice  
<sup>13</sup> before the LORD. For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth.  
He shall judge the world with righteousness,  
And the peoples with His truth.

<sup>57</sup> Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had also become a disciple of Jesus. <sup>58</sup> This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him. <sup>59</sup> When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, <sup>60</sup> and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed. <sup>61</sup> And Mary Magdalene was there, and the other Mary, sitting opposite the tomb.

<sup>62</sup> On the next day, which followed the Day of Preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees gathered together to Pilate, <sup>63</sup> saying, "Sir, we remember, while He was still alive, how that deceiver said, 'After three days I will rise.'" <sup>64</sup> Therefore command that the tomb be made secure until the third day, lest His disciples come by night and steal Him *away*, and say to the people, 'He has risen from the dead.' So the last deception will be worse than the first." <sup>65</sup> Pilate said to them, "You have a guard; go your way, make *it* as secure as you know how." <sup>66</sup> So they went and made the tomb secure, sealing the stone and setting the guard.

**28** Now after the Sabbath, as the first *day* of the week began to dawn, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb. <sup>2</sup> And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat on it. <sup>3</sup> His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow. <sup>4</sup> And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead *men*. <sup>5</sup> But the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. <sup>6</sup> He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. <sup>7</sup> And go quickly and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him. Behold, I have told you." <sup>8</sup> So they went out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to bring His disciples word.

<sup>9</sup> And as they went to tell His disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, "Rejoice!" So they came and held Him by the feet and worshiped Him. <sup>10</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go *and* tell My brethren to go to Galilee, and there they will see Me."

<sup>11</sup> Now while they were going, behold, some of the guard came into the city and reported to the chief priests all the things that had happened. <sup>12</sup> When they had assembled with the elders and consulted together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers, <sup>13</sup> saying, "Tell them, 'His disciples came at night and stole Him *away* while we slept.'" <sup>14</sup> And if this comes to the governor's ears, we will appease him and make you secure." <sup>15</sup> So they took the money and did as they were instructed; and this saying is commonly reported among the Jews until this day.

<sup>16</sup> Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them. <sup>17</sup> When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted.

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." **Amen.**
