<sup>6</sup> For this cause everyone who is godly shall pray to You In a time when You may be found; Surely in a flood of great waters they shall not come near him.

<sup>7</sup> You *are* my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of deliverance. *Selah* 

<sup>8</sup> I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will guide you with My eye.

<sup>9</sup>Do not be like the horse *or* like the mule, w*hich* have no understanding, which must be harnessed with bit and bridle, Else they will not come near you.

# **Revelation 14**

- 1 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred *and* forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.
- <sup>2</sup> And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps.
- <sup>3</sup> They sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth.
- <sup>4</sup> These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes.

These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb.

- <sup>5</sup> And in their mouth was found no deceit, for they are without fault before the throne of God.
- <sup>6</sup> Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—
- <sup>7</sup> saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."

Mark 1:14 Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to

Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

- <sup>15</sup> and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."
- <sup>16</sup> And as He walked by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen.
- <sup>17</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men."
- <sup>18</sup> They immediately left their nets and followed Him.
- <sup>19</sup> When He had gone a little farther from there, He saw James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, who also were in the boat mending their nets.
- <sup>20</sup> And immediately He called them, and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired servants, and went after Him.
- <sup>21</sup> Then they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and taught.
- <sup>22</sup> And they were astonished at His teaching, for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.
