**Psalm 32** Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.

**<sup>2</sup> Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.**

**<sup>3</sup> When I kept silent, my bones grew old  
Through my groaning all the day long.**

**<sup>4</sup> For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me;  
My vitality was turned into the drought of  
summer. *Selah***

**<sup>5</sup> I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden.**

I said, “I will confess my transgressions to the LORD,”  
And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. *Selah*

**<sup>6</sup> For this cause everyone who is godly shall pray to You  
In a time when You may be found; Surely in a flood of  
great waters they shall not come near him.**

**<sup>7</sup> You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from  
trouble; You shall surround me with songs of  
deliverance. *Selah***

**<sup>8</sup> I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should  
go; I will guide you with My eye.**

**<sup>9</sup> Do not be like the horse or like the mule, which have no  
understanding, which must be harnessed with bit and bridle,  
Else they will not come near you.**

**<sup>10</sup> Many sorrows shall be to the wicked; But he who trusts  
in the LORD, mercy shall surround him.**

**<sup>11</sup> Be glad in the LORD and rejoice, you righteous;  
And shout for joy, all you upright in heart!**

## Revelation 14

<sup>1</sup> Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred *and* forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.

<sup>2</sup> And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps.

<sup>3</sup> They sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred *and* forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth.

<sup>4</sup> These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from *among* men, *being* firstfruits to God and to the Lamb.

<sup>5</sup> And in their mouth was found no deceit, for they are without fault before the throne of God.

<sup>6</sup> **Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—**

<sup>7</sup> saying with a loud voice, “Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.”

**Mark 1:14** Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to

Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

<sup>15</sup> and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

<sup>16</sup> **And as He walked by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen.**

<sup>17</sup> **Then Jesus said to them, “Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men.”**

<sup>18</sup> **They immediately left their nets and followed Him.**

<sup>19</sup> **When He had gone a little farther from there, He saw James the *son* of Zebedee, and John his brother, who also *were* in the boat mending their nets.**

<sup>20</sup> **And immediately He called them, and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired servants, and went after Him.**

<sup>21</sup> **Then they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and taught.**

<sup>22</sup> **And they were astonished at His teaching, for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.**
