The Heritage of the Righteous and the Calamity of the Wicked A Psalm of David. 37 Do not fret because of evildoers, Nor be envious of the workers of iniquity. ² For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, And wither as the green herb. ³Trust in the LORD, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. ⁴Delight yourself also in the LORD, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. ⁵Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring *it* to pass. ⁶He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday. ⁷Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. ⁸Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; Do not fret—*it* only *causes* harm. ⁹For evildoers shall be cut off; But those who wait on the LORD, They shall inherit the earth. ¹⁰ For yet a little while and the wicked *shall be* no *more*; Indeed, you will look carefully for his place, but it *shall be* no *more*. ¹¹But the meek shall inherit the earth, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace. ¹² The wicked plots against the just, and gnashes at him with his teeth. ¹³ The Lord laughs at him, for He sees that his day is coming. ¹⁴ The wicked have drawn the sword and have bent their bow, To cast down the poor and needy, to slay those who are of upright conduct. ¹⁵ Their sword shall enter their own heart, and their bows shall be broken. ¹⁶A little that a righteous man has is better than the riches of many wicked. ¹⁷ For the arms of the wicked shall be broken, But the LORD upholds the righteous. ¹⁸ The LORD knows the days of the upright, And their inheritance shall be forever. ¹⁹ They shall not be ashamed in the evil time,

And in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.

²⁰ But the wicked shall perish; And the enemies of the LORD, Like the splendor of the meadows, shall vanish.
Into smoke they shall vanish away.
²¹ The wicked borrows and does not repay, But the righteous shows mercy and gives.
²² For those blessed by Him shall inherit the earth, But those cursed by Him shall be cut off.
²³ The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, And He delights in his way.
²⁴ Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; For the LORD upholds him with His hand.

Acts 11:19 Now those who were scattered after the persecution that arose over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to no one but the Jews only.

²⁰ But some of them were men from Cyprus and Cyrene, who, when they had come to Antioch, spoke to the Hellenists, preaching the Lord Jesus.

²¹ And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number believed and turned to the Lord.

²² Then news of these things came to the ears of the church in Jerusalem, and they sent out Barnabas to go as far as Antioch.

²³ When he came and had seen the grace of God, he was glad, and encouraged them all that with purpose of heart they should continue with the Lord.

²⁴ For he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord.
