They are more than the hairs of my head; Therefore my heart fails me.

14 *Let them be ashamed and brought to mutual confusion*

15 Let them be confounded because of their shame,

2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:19-21; Titus 1:2; Hebrews 6:13-18

Acts 12:23 Then immediately an angel of the Lord struck him, because he did not give glory to God. And he was eaten by worms and died. ²⁴**But the word of God grew and multiplied.** ²⁵ And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem when they had fulfilled *their* ministry, and they also took with them John whose surname was Mark.
