<sup>11</sup> So the King will greatly desire your beauty;

Because He is your Lord, worship Him.

<sup>12</sup> And the daughter of Tyre *will come* with a gift; The rich among the people will seek your favor.

13 The royal daughter is all glorious within the palace;

Her clothing is woven with gold.

<sup>14</sup> She shall be brought to the King in robes of many colors;

The virgins, her companions who follow her, shall be brought to You.

15 With gladness and rejoicing they shall be brought;

They shall enter the King's palace.

16 Instead of Your fathers shall be Your sons,

Whom You shall make princes in all the earth.

17 I will make Your name to be remembered in all generations;

Therefore the people shall praise You forever and ever.
