Psalm 77 I cried out to God with my voice—

To God with my voice; And He gave ear to me.

² **In the day of my trouble I sought the Lord; My hand was stretched out in the night without ceasing; My soul refused to be comforted.**

³ I remembered God, and was troubled;

I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed. *Selah*

⁴ **You hold my eyelids open; I am so troubled that I cannot speak.**

⁵ I have considered the days of old, the years of ancient times.

⁶ **I call to remembrance my song in the night;**

I meditate within my heart, and my spirit makes diligent search.

⁷ Will the Lord cast off forever? And will He be favorable no more?

⁸ **Has His mercy ceased forever? Has His promise failed forevermore?**

⁹ Has God forgotten to be gracious?

Has He in anger shut up His tender mercies? *Selah*

¹⁰ **And I said, "This is my anguish;**

But I will remember the years of the right hand of the Most High."

¹¹ I will remember the works of the LORD;

Surely I will remember Your wonders of old.

¹² **I will also meditate on all Your work, and talk of Your deeds.**

¹³ Your way, O God, *is* in the sanctuary;

Who *is* so great a God as *our* God?

¹⁴ **You are the God who does wonders;**

You have declared Your strength among the peoples.

¹⁵ You have with *Your* arm redeemed Your people,

The sons of Jacob and Joseph. *Selah*

¹⁶ **The waters saw You, O God; The waters saw You, they were afraid; The depths also trembled.**

¹⁷ The clouds poured out water; The skies sent out a sound;

Your arrows also flashed about.

¹⁸ **The voice of Your thunder was in the whirlwind;**

The lightnings lit up the world; The earth trembled and shook.

¹⁹ Your way *was* in the sea, Your path in the great waters,

And Your footsteps were not known.

²⁰ **You led Your people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron.**

The Psalm begins with a cry of distress: the psalmist has been experiencing profound difficulties, and his cries to God appear to have been ignored; only his memories of the past seem to bring anything even resembling joy.
