Psalm 43 When He worked His signs in Egypt, and His wonders in the field of Zoan; ⁴⁴ Turned their rivers into blood, and their streams, that they could not drink. ⁴⁵ He sent swarms of flies among them, which devoured them, And frogs, which destroyed them. ⁴⁶ He also gave their crops to the caterpillar, and their labor to the locust. ⁴⁷ He destroyed their vines with hail, and their sycamore trees with frost. ⁴⁸ He also gave up their cattle to the hail, and their flocks to fiery lightning. ⁴⁹ He cast on them the fierceness of His anger, Wrath, indignation, and trouble, by sending angels of destruction among them. ⁵⁰ He made a path for His anger; He did not spare their soul from death, But gave their life over to the plague, ⁵¹ And destroyed all the firstborn in Egypt, The first of *their* strength in the tents of Ham. ⁵² But He made His own people go forth like sheep, And guided them in the wilderness like a flock; ⁵³ And He led them on safely, so that they did not fear; But the sea overwhelmed their enemies. ⁵⁴ And He brought them to His holy border, This mountain which His right hand had acquired. ⁵⁵ He also drove out the nations before them, allotted them an inheritance by survey, And made the tribes of Israel dwell in their tents. ⁵⁶ Yet they tested and provoked the Most High God, And did not keep His testimonies, ⁵⁷ But turned back and acted unfaithfully like their fathers; They were turned aside like a deceitful bow. ⁵⁸ For they provoked Him to anger with their high places, And moved Him to jealousy with their carved images. ⁵⁹When God heard *this*, He was furious, and greatly abhorred Israel, ⁶⁰ So that He forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, The tent He had placed among men. ⁶¹ And delivered His strength into captivity, and His glory into the enemy's hand. ⁶² He also gave His people over to the sword. And was furious with His inheritance. ⁶³ The fire consumed their young men, and their maidens were not given in marriage. ⁶⁴ Their priests fell by the sword, and their widows made no lamentation. ⁶⁵ Then the Lord awoke as *from* sleep, like a mighty man who shouts because of wine. ⁶⁶ And He beat back His enemies; He put them to a perpetual reproach. ⁶⁷ Moreover He rejected the tent of Joseph, and did not choose the tribe of Ephraim, ⁶⁸ But chose the tribe of Judah, Mount Zion which He loved. ⁶⁹ And He built His sanctuary like the heights, Like the earth which He has established forever. ⁷⁰ He also chose David His servant, and took him from the sheepfolds: ⁷¹ From following the ewes that had young He brought him,

To shepherd Jacob His people, and Israel His inheritance. ⁷² So he shepherded them according to the integrity of his heart, And guided them by the skillfulness of his hands.

Acts 27:38 So when they had eaten enough, they lightened the ship and threw out the wheat into the sea.

³⁹When it was day, they did not recognize the land; but they observed a bay with a beach, onto which they planned to run the ship if possible. ⁴⁰And they let go the anchors and left *them* in the sea, meanwhile loosing the rudder ropes; and they hoisted the mainsail to the wind and made for shore. ⁴¹But striking a place where two seas met, they ran the ship aground; and the prow stuck fast and remained immovable, but the stern was being broken up by the violence of the waves.

⁴² And the soldiers' plan was to kill the prisoners, lest any of them should swim away and escape. ⁴³ But the centurion, wanting to save Paul, kept them from *their* purpose, and commanded that those who could swim should jump *overboard* first and get to land, ⁴⁴ and the rest, some on boards and some on *parts* of the ship. And so it was that they all escaped safely to land.
