Will You prolong Your anger to all generations?

<sup>6</sup> **Will You not revive us again, that Your people may rejoice in You?**

<sup>7</sup> Show us Your mercy, LORD, and grant us Your salvation.

<sup>8</sup> **I will hear what God the LORD will speak, for He will speak peace**

**To His people and to His saints; But let them not turn back to folly.**

<sup>9</sup> Surely His salvation *is* near to those who fear Him,

That glory may dwell in our land.

<sup>10</sup> **Mercy and truth have met together;**

**Righteousness and peace have kissed.**

<sup>11</sup> Truth shall spring out of the earth,

And righteousness shall look down from heaven.

<sup>12</sup> **Yes, the LORD will give *what is good*;**

**And our land will yield its increase.**

<sup>13</sup> **Righteousness will go before Him,**

**And shall make His footsteps *our* pathway.**

**\*John 1- In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. <sup>4</sup> In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. <sup>5</sup> And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. <sup>6</sup> There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. <sup>7</sup> This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all through him might believe. <sup>8</sup> He was not that Light, but *was sent* to bear witness of that Light. <sup>9</sup> That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. <sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. <sup>11</sup> He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. <sup>12</sup> But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: <sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.**

<sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.
