<sup>11</sup> Teach me Your way, O LORD;

I will walk in Your truth; Unite my heart to fear Your name.

<sup>12</sup> **I will praise You, O Lord my God, with all my heart,**

**And I will glorify Your name forevermore.**

<sup>13</sup> For great *is* Your mercy toward me,

And You have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.

<sup>14</sup> **O God, the proud have risen against me, and a mob of violent *men* have sought my life, and have not set You before them.**

<sup>15</sup> But You, O Lord, *are* a God full of compassion, and gracious, Longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth.

<sup>16</sup> **Oh, turn to me, and have mercy on me! Give Your strength to Your servant and save the son of Your maidservant.**

<sup>17</sup> **Show me a sign for good, that those who hate me may see *it* and be ashamed, because You, LORD, have helped me and comforted me.**
