Dear Beloved in Christ,

Greetings, peace, and blessings in His precious name. Because of the Lord's mercy and your prevailing prayers, my life was spared. I thank my daughter Mano for updating you on my health issues and requests for prayer. On July 31st and August 3rd, I went through the valley of the shadow of death at our home for the elderly and destitute in Mount Zion. In the village of Mt. Zion, there were no specialty hospitals or emergency treatment clinics. Praise God for Dr. Ajay who had recently set up a small clinic in the village. He was able to immediately diagnose and treat me. However, my symptoms became too serious when fluid entered my lungs. Dr. Ajay recommended that I be transferred immediately to the Apollo Multispecialty Hospital-Madurai. After spending three days in the Intensive Care Unit, by God's grace, I was moved to a general ward, where I stayed for seven more days. The Lord graciously saved my life. I am grateful to the doctors, nurses, and staff who looked after me. I praise God for my daughter Mano and all who cared for me during this critical time.

I would like to extend my heartfelt thanks to my supporters, some who have stood beside me for the past 40 plus years, for my supporting churches, and all those who fervently prayed for me and financially helped me. I also sincerely thank our MissionGO staff for their timely care and support.

Kindly continue to pray for my health, as it has become increasingly difficult to regain full health due to my age of 84 years. I praise God for the strength He gives for each new day.

May the Lord bless and keep you all. Thank you once again for all your love, prayers, and support. My heart is full of thanks and gratitude.
