Our Beginnings: The Story of Hearts for the Homeless

The journey of Hearts for the Homeless began with a powerful story. Founder Ron Calandra's firsthand experience with homelessness, even living in the back of a Ryder truck for a time, led him toward a path of community service. From 1988 to 1990, Ron served as a missionary in Mexico, raising awareness about poverty and initiating programs to support some of Mexico's poorest areas. Inspired by this work, he returned to Buffalo in 1990 to establish Hearts for the Homeless®, with a mission to support those experiencing homelessness and poverty in Western New York.

Hearts for the Homeless Today

Today, Hearts for the Homeless serves Buffalo and the surrounding areas, providing food, resources, and hope to the poor and homeless. At the Hearts Campus, we help create better living environments and strengthen community connections.
