Responsible Jewish evangelism has characterized Chosen People Ministries from its inception. Over the years, different aspects of our ministry's outreach have continued and expanded. The early work was a real family ministry. Mothers would come to the Mission to participate in women's activities. They would also bring their children, who took part in children's programs, which, in turn, resulted in fathers coming to the Mission.

Through the dedicated work of early missionaries, many individuals and entire families came to believe in Jesus. There are numerous Jewish-Christian family trees whose spiritual roots began through the outreach of Chosen People Ministries. Several of them, including some of our staff, are in full-time service for the Lord.
